Fr. Timothy reflection

If Anyone Would be First, Let Him be the Servant of All
In today's Gospel Jesus finds his followers arguing among themselves about who is the greatest among them. Through baptism in Christ we have been inserted into the death and resurrection of the Lord who has made us a worthy sacrifice. The source of our Christian existence is then the same humility that our Lord lived. We are born to serve in and through him who served everyone, even to the point of death. Humble service is therefore central to the life of a Christian, and all arguments or competitions to climb higher in importance are completely contrary to our faith. Whoever would be considered first would be the servant of his brother and sister like Jesus. So what makes us, his followers, worthy is the possibility he gives us to imitate the humility he shows us. All scandals will disappear in as much as we all learn to follow Christ along the path of humble service.

Other Celebrations this week:

Monday 20th – Saints Andrew Kim-Tae-gon, priest, Paul Chong Ha-sang and companions, Martyrs. This Korean priest and seminarian were martyred in 1846. 103 other martyrs gave their lives between 1839 and 1867.

Tuesday 21st – Feast of St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist. The first book of the New Testament is attributed to him. Tradition holds that he preached in Judea and Ethiopia where he was martyred. He is patron of accountants and customs officers.

Thursday 23rd – St. Pius of Pietrelcina, priest. "Padre Pio" is one of the most famous contemporary saints. He became a Capuchin monk and was known for great holiness and for being a good confessor. His life was devoted to the Eucharist and prayer. He died in 1968 and is patron saint of civil defense volunteers and Catholic adolescents.

Todos los escándalos comienzan a desvanecer en cuanto nosotros todos aprendamos a seguir a Cristo por el camino del servicio humilde.

Celebraciones de esta semana:

Lunes 20 – Santos Andrés Kim-Tae-gon, sacerdote, Pablo Chong Ha-sang y compañeros, mártires. Este sacerdote y seminarista coreanos fueron martirizados en 1846. 103 otros mártires dieron su vida por la fe en Corea desde 1839 a 1867.

Martes 21 – Fiesta de San Mateo, Apóstol y Evangelista. Es autor del primer libro del nuevo testamento, el evangelio según San Mateo. La tradición enseña que predicaba en Judea y en Etiopía donde sufrió el martirio. Es santo patrono de los contadores y funcionarios de aduanas.

Jueves 23 – San Pío de Pietrelcina, sacerdote. "Padre Pio" es de los santos contemporáneos más famosos. Se hizo fraile capuchino y fue reconocido por su grande santidad. Fue grande confesor de almas. Se dedicaba la vida a la Eucaristía y a la oración. Murió en 1968 y es patrono de los voluntarios de la defensa civil y de los adolescentes católicos.

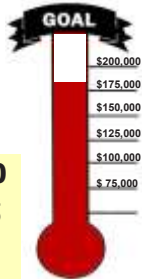
